

2022 NASP® Scholarships

Individual Shoot-off Scholarships:

Archers will qualify for the individual scholarship shoot-off at the NASP® Western and Eastern national tournaments. Scores will be combined from the Western and Eastern national tournaments and the top 5 male and top 5 female archers (including ties) from the combined scores will qualify and be announced in advance of the 2022 NASP® Open Championship tournament. In addition, the top over-all female, and top over-all male archers from both events (if not already qualified) will also qualify to participate.

The individual scholarship shoot-off will be held after the 2022 NASP® Open Championship, on June 25 in Louisville Kentucky, just prior to the award ceremony.

Individual scholarship shoot-off format:

- Each archer will shoot a 5-arrow end from 15 meters for practice
- Each archer will shoot a 5-arrow scoring end from 15 meters
- Scholarship award levels will be determined by order of elimination based on scores among these contestants
- Award levels will be:

Random Scholarship Awards:

Thanks to its many generous sponsors NASP® is delighted to announce that 120 \$500.00 bullseye scholarships will be awarded randomly to student archers simply for their participation. Upon graduation, archers can apply these funds to any post-secondary educational or training program of their choice.

Awarding of random scholarships

- 100 random scholarship awards will be drawn from the names of all archers participating in the Western and Eastern national tournaments and announced after the NASP® Eastern National tournament.
- 20 random scholarships will be awarded during the NASP® Open Championship tournament. One random scholarship will be awarded after each flight of this tournament.

Team Scholarship Awards:

Team scholarships will be awarded to the overall top three finishing High School teams from the combined scores of the Western and Eastern national tournaments.

Team scholarship award process:

- High School team scores from the Western and Eastern national tournaments will be combined
- The overall top three High School teams will be determined from the combined scores
- Winning teams will be announced during the awards at the Eastern national tournament May 13th in Louisville Kentucky
- Up to 24 1st place High School team members will receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship
- Up to 24 2nd place High School team members will receive a \$750.00 scholarship
- Up to 24 3rd place High School team members will receive a \$500.00 scholarship
