#### BACK TO SCHOOL AND BACK TO NASP®

Welcome back to school and the start of archery season for many NASP® schools! 2024 is looking to be a great season for our archers. Last year, over 1.3 million archers from 8,967 schools participated in NASP® and of those, 34,577 students were enrolled as Academic Archers.

#### The importance of in-school lessons

NASP® wants EVERY child in your school to have the opportunity to love archery just like you and other NASP® student archers. Because of the in-school component of NASP®, over one million students get to try archery for the first time and many fall in love with it

Just a reminder, each school must lead 10 hours of in-class instruction during the regularly scheduled school day annually to remain active.

#### NASP Open Championship to become The NASP® Championship

The National Archery in the Schools Program will be changing the name of "the NASP® Open Championship" for 2024. Beginning with the July 2024 tournament in Daytona Florida the culminating tournament of the year will be titled "the NASP® Championship". Qualification details will be out soon with the tournament registration documents. There will be tier qualifications for the event based on team and individual scores from the two National tournaments, with an open final tier available to others, if the previous tiers do not fill up.

#### **ST JUDE E-CHAMPIONSHIP**

#### **NOVEMBER-APRIL** VIRTUAL

NASP® archers, teams, and families raised over \$28,000 for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital last year. The tournament is free, but a donation for each entry is encouraged. Donations can be made by a coach or parents in the name of the school. Proceeds will be donated to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. All students in every NASP® school are eligible to participate. The virtual tournaments in this series will occur monthly during the school year and your team can enter once per month. Tournament registration must be completed by their school's active BAI.


